It is intended to establish a Panel of Designated Examiners/Assessors with relevant expertise who wish to be considered for this purpose. The areas of expertise that are looked for are as follows:

- Aircraft Maintenance on Turbine/Piston Engines
- Operation of Glass Cockpit / Fly by wire aircraft/helicopters
- Operation of float planes/helicopters/hot air balloons/gliders/airships
- Flight Instructions
- Air traffic Control Instructions
- Train the Trainers
- Safety Management Systems auditing
- Maintenance of CNS equipment
- Aviation Security Instructions
- Airport Ground Handling
- Transport of Dangerous Goods by air
- Aeronautical Meteorology
- Development of Aeronautical Charts
- Aerodrome Master Planning and designing
- Search and Rescue Operations
- Aeronautical Information Management
- Environment protection due to aircraft noise and emissions

Personnel having sound knowledge, skills and work experience of not less than fifteen (15) years in any of the abovementioned areas may register their interest with the CAASL by submitting the following information:

- Details of relevant experience in respective subjects above
- Details of rates charged for advices, consultations, Indication of general availability, where possible.
