By a Note dated 1/4/57, the Chargé d'affaires *ad interim* of Ceylon (now Sri Lanka), on behalf of the Government of Ceylon, informed the Secretary of State of the United States that "although no notice was given by Ceylon of adherence to the Transit Agreement, the Government of Ceylon considers itself a party to the International Air Services Transit Agreement since 31st May, 1945, the date on which the United Kingdom Government accepted the Agreement . . .".

By a Note dated 24/4/51, the Government of Sri Lanka declared that it considered itself bound by the Warsaw Convention (before Sri Lanka became independent, acceptance of the Convention was effected by the United Kingdom on 3/12/34).
