AN ACT TO AMEND THE AIR NAVIGATION ACT AND THE AIR NAVIGATION (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ACT, NO. 2 OF 1982

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Air Navigation (Special Provisions) Act, No. 11 of 1983.

Short title.

2. Section 23 of the Air Navigation Act (replaced by Act No. 2 of 1982) is hereby amended by the repeal of subsection (3) of that section and the substitution therefor of the following subsection:—

Amendment of section 23 of Chapter 365.

“ (3) The Agent shall retain from and out of the fees, taxes or charges collected or recovered by him on behalf of the Government—

(a) such fee as may be specified by the Minister by Order published in the *Gazette*, for the services provided by him in the discharge of his functions; and

(b) such other sum which may be required for capital expenditure as may be determined by the Minister with the concurrence of the Minister in charge of the subject of Finance for the purpose of the development on behalf of the Government of aerodromes or airports, not exceeding fees or charges recovered by him on behalf of the Government in connection with the landing, using or parking of aircraft.”

3. Section 8 of the Air Navigation (Special Provisions) Act, No. 2 of 1982, is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraphs (a) and (b) of that section, of the following paragraphs:—

Amendment of section 8 of Act No. 2 of 1982.

“ (a) (i) all immovable property in the possession and control of the Airports Authority on the day immediately preceding the appointed date shall be transferred to, and vest in, the Director of Civil Aviation;

(ii) all movable property including money to which the Airports Authority is entitled to, or which is in its possession and control on the day immediately preceding the appointed date shall be transferred to, and vest in, the Agent appointed under section 21A of the Air Navigation Act;

(ii) a person who was, immediately prior to his appointment to a post on the staff of the Agent, an employee in the employment of the Airports Authority of Sri Lanka, established by Airports Authority Act, No. 46 of 1979, by reason of his having exercised the option referred to in section 31 (2) (a) of that Act, and having, or deemed to be having, less than ten years and not less than eight years pensionable service in the public service.

“relevant period of service” in relation to a person to whom this subsection applies, means the period for which such person would have to serve in the public service to complete ten years pensionable service in the public service, had he remained in the public service after the date of his appointment to a post on the staff of the Agent.’; and

(2) by the substitution in paragraph (a) of subsection (19) of that section for the words and figures “any public officer, other than a public officer to whom subsections (16) and (17) apply, may,” of the words “any public officer may,”.
