Issuance of Private Pilot Licence / Aeroplanes



a) Requirements:-

1. Age not less than 17 years.
2. Medical fitness (Class I/ II).
3. Security Clearance.
4. PPL Technical Examination and any other knowledge requirement.
5. English Language Proficiency. (Level 4 or higher)
6. Shall hold a current Student Pilot Licence together with a current Medical certificate issued on CAASL.
7. Flying experience as “C” bellow.
8. Flying School recommendation for skill test.
9. Refer para 1.3.1.4. of ASN 55

b) Supportive documents to be submitted:-

1. Duly completed Application for Issuance of PPL (CAA/PL/I/02).
2. Duly completed Personnel Particulars form (CAA/PL/M/12)
3. Duly completed Application for Medical Examination (CAA/PL/E/01)
4. Duly completed evaluation form for English Language Proficiency check (CAA/PL/E/08)
5. Course completion certificate from flying training organization
6. Log Book certified by flying training organization together with copies indicating total and recent flying experience.
7. Stamp Size 2 colour photos (2x2.5 cm)
8. Detailed breakdown of flying experience
9. Flying test report and observer’s report.

c) Minimum Flying experience:- Refer para 1.3.1.3. of ASN 55

1. For Private Pilot Licence.

- Total 40 hrs,
- Cross country 05 hrs as PIC
- Instrument 05 hrs.
- One triangular X country with minimum of 150 nm of two full stop landings.
- Solo 10 hrs.

d) Procedure:-

1. Submit Application for PPL CAA/PL/I/02 issuance with supportive documents above (b), 1 to 09.
2. Obtain security clearance.
3. Obtain Class I Medical Certificate.
4. Appear for following examinations at CAASL.
 - PPL Technical Examination.
 - English Language Proficiency check
 - Flying test with appropriate type of Aircraft.
6. Obtain SPL. ***If you don’t have valid SPL & see the procedure for obtaining of SPL.***
7. Finally collect letter for flight test and complete it, Submit Examiner report & ATC observer’s report.
8. Complete any other requirements if found deficient in the evaluation processes
