Direct Issuance of CPL

a) Requirements:-

- 1. Age not less than 18 years.
- 2. Medical fitness (Class I).
- 3. Security Clearance
- 4. Successful completion of ground training and flying training in approved Flying School.
- 5. CPL/IR Theory Examinations or ATPL Theory examinations. (Ref. ASN 055 and AIC B04/10 for more details)
- 6. Flying experience as "C" bellow.
- 7. English Language Proficiency. (Level 4 or higher)
- 8. Flying school recommendation for theory examinations and skill test.
- 9. Successful completion of skill test
- 10. All other requirements stipulated in Para 4 of IS 051 which you can download from the website <u>www.caa.lk</u>

b) Supportive documents to be submitted:-

- 1. Duly completed Personnel Particulars form
- 2. Duly completed Application for Medical Examination
- 3. Duly completed Application for Theory Examinations with recommendation letter from approved flying school.
- 4. Duly completed evaluation form for English Language Proficiency check (CAA/PL/E/08)
- 5. Log Book certified by flying training organization together with copies indicating total and recent flying experience.
- 6. Copy of NIC/Birth certificate.
- 7. Stamp Size 2 colour photos (2x2.5 cm)

- 8. Course completion certificate from approved flying school
- 9. Detailed breakdown of flying experience
- 10. Flying school recommendation letter/ instructor report or log book copies for skill test
- 11. Skill test report and ATC observer's report.
- c) Flying experience: Refer Para 4.3 of IS 051
 - 1. For Commercial Pilot Licence.
 - ➤ Total 200 hrs, or 150 hrs if completed during a course of approved training
 - 100 hrs as PIC or in the case of a course of approved training, 70 hrs as PIC hrs (PIC/US is not considered as PIC)
 - Cross country 20 hrs as PIC. Not less than 540km (300NM) in the course of which full-stop landings at two different aerodromes shall be made. (PIC/US is not considered as PIC)
 - > Instrument 10 hrs. (Maximum ground time 05 hrs)
 - Night flying 5 hrs including 5 take-offs and 5 landings as PIC. (If night rating is sought)
 - 2. For Instrument Rating.
 - Cross country 50 hrs as PIC hrs

➢ Instrument 40 hrs in aircraft of whoch not more than 20hrs (instrument ground time) Ground Time shall be under supervision of authorized Instructor

d) Procedure:-

- 1. Join an approved Flying School & follow approved training program.
- 2. Once the course is completed submit course completion certificate to sit for knowledge examination.
- 3. Register with the computerized Licensing System through www.caa.lk
- 4. Create the user profile and add the Commercial Pilot Licence Issuance application form.
- 5. If you need any assistance to create the profile or add new application, press the "Help" button.
- 6. Visit the Personnel Licensing Section with the original documents and make the relevant payment to commence the process of evaluation of the application.
- 7. Submit Personnel Particulars form to obtain Security Clearance
- 8. Submit application for Medical Examination under a CAA Medical Examiner to obtain Class I Medical Certificate.
- 9. Appear for theory examinations, ELPC examinations at CAASL.
- 8. Obtain SPL. If you don't have valid Licence & see the procedure for obtaining of SPL.
- 9. Complete recent flying & hand over instructor report or log book copies. *If you don't have recent flying experience*.
- 10. If all other requirements are completed collect letter for flight test and submit Flight Test Examiner report & ATC observer's report.
