a) Requirements:-

Before expiry date of licence

1. Medical Fitness (Class I)
2. Security Clearance
3. Recent Experience according to 2.1 of IS 071.
4. Pilot Proficiency Check
For more details refer IS 071 para 2
5. ELPC Validity

If the date of Renewal is lapsed

Not less than 02 years

1. Medical Fitness (Class I)
2. Aircraft type rating flight test (PPC V)
For more details refer IS 071 para 3.1

More than 02 years less than 5 yrs

1. Medical Fitness (Class I)
2. Aircraft type examination (Technical)
3. Pass Air law, Flight rules and procedures
4. Pass Aircraft type rating flight test

More than 05 years, less than 10 yrs

1. Medical Fitness (Class I)
2. Pass Air law, Flight rules and procedures
3. A composite paper for Human factors, Meteorology and Navigation
4. Pass Aircraft type examination (Technical)
5. Pass Aircraft type rating flight test (PPC V)

More than 10 years

1. Medical Fitness (Class I)
2. Pass all technical examinations
3. Aircraft type rating flight test (PPC V)
For more details refer IS 071 para 3.1

Reactivation of a lapsed Instrument Ratings (IR)

Not less than 12months

1. Undergo training as approved by DGCA
2. Flight test (IR Check I) carried out in accordance with renewal flight test requirements
For more details refer IS 071 para 3.2.1

More than 12 months

1. Undergo training as approved by DGCA
2. Flight test (IR Check II) carried out in accordance with renewal flight test requirements
For more details refer IS 071 para 3.2.2

Reactivation of lapsed AFI/FI Ratings

Not less than 12months

1. Undergo training as approved by DGCA
2. Flight test (PPC IV)
For more details refer IS 071 para 3.3.1

More than 12months

1. Undergo training as approved by DGCA
2. Flight test (PPC IV)
For more details refer IS 071 para 3.3.2

b) Supportive documents to be submitted:

1. Duly completed Application for Medical Examination (CAA/PL/E/01)
2. If security Clearance is lapsed, Submit Personal Particulars form No. CAA/PL/M/13 to obtain Security Clearance.
3. Log Book certified by flying school/ Airline together with copies indicating total and recent flying experience
4. Pilot Proficiency Report / skill test report

c) Procedure:-

1. Register with the computerized Licensing System through www.caa.lk
2. Create the user profile (if user profile has not been created) and add the CPL/ATPL Renewal application form.
3. If you need any assistance to create the profile or add new application, press the “Help” button.
4. Submit application for Medical Examination under a CAA Medical Examiner to obtain Class I Medical Certificate.
5. Submit Log Book copies certified by Airlines
6. Check the status of the application through your profile in the Licensing System.
7. Visit the Personnel Licensing Section and make the relevant payment to commence the process of evaluation of the application.
8. The requirements for Renewal of CPL/ATPL have been published in **Implementing Standard 071** which you can download from the website.

Please note if you have not gained recent experience and or competency in flying during the period of validity of licence, you may renew the licence for training purposes
