Conducting Business Activities with Non-Licensed Travel Agents

In terms of the Air Navigation (Special Provisions) Act No 55 of 1992, any person or organization who desires to carry out the business of air transportation in Sri Lanka is required to obtain an Air Transport Providers (Passenger) Licence issued by the Director General of Civil Aviation.

It is observed that there are airlines in Sri Lanka who carry out the business of air transport with travel agencies who have not obtained the Air Transport Providers (Passenger) Licence from the DGCA.

Therefore you are hereby instructed to conduct your business activities pertaining to air transport only with persons or organizations who possess a valid Air Transport Providers (Passenger) Licence issued by the Director General of Civil Aviation.

The on-line and off-line airlines are strictly instructed to adhere to the above instructions and to comply accordingly.
